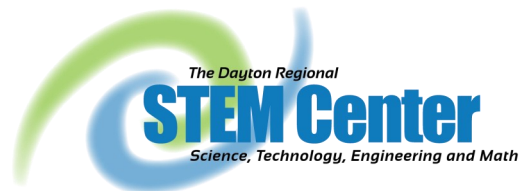


Project Based Learning in STEM Workshop

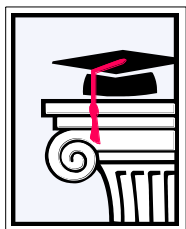
Are you a K-8 teacher looking for fun, practical, hands-on, science and math learning experiences to integrate **STEM and career connections** in your classroom?
